

# Q & A

## **When do registrations open?**

Registrations open the first week of Term 1 in early February, a notice will be posted in the school newsletter and email sent to existing players.

## **How much does it cost?**

Registration fee for 2024 is \$250 and covers 1 hr weekly team training & game day. Uniform purchase is additional.

## **Can I use my Kids Active Voucher (KAV)?**

We are no longer accepting Kids Active Vouchers.

## **What competitions/products do you offer?**

We offer both Mixed and Girls only competitions.

Mixed Competitions are run for U6 – U12. Games are played on a Saturday morning, generally between 8am – 1pm with the younger kids playing first.

Girls Only Competitions are run for G8 – G12. Games are played on Sunday morning, generally between 9am – 1pm.

We also offer additional skills training sessions for kids keen to develop their skills beyond the weekly training/games. See Skills Session Q&A

## **What age group should I register for?**

Generally, players would register in the age group they are turning that year however sometime younger kids will play up an age group to play with their classmates.

Below is a guide:

- Under 6 – Kindy, Born on or after 1st January 2016
- Under 7 – Year 1, Born on or after 1st January 2015
- Under 8 – Year 2, Born on or after 1st January 2014
- Under 9 – Year 3, Born on or after 1st January 2013
- Under 10 – Year 4, Born on or after 1st January 2012
- Under 11 – Year 5, Born on or after 1st January 2011
- Under 12 – Year 6, Born on or after 1st January 2010

\* Players may only register in MiniRoos if they are four (4) years of age or older as at 11:59pm on the December 31 of the previous year.

- \* players who fall slightly outside of these guidelines can apply for a special dispensation under exceptional circumstances. Please contact the Registrar to discuss further.

### **How are Teams selected/formed?**

U7 – U12 age groups are divided into teams based that best suit their ability. Kindy – are not Graded but placed into groups with some/all of their classmates.

### **Can I request to play with a friend?**

Although we believe that for the enjoyment of all players, players should play in teams with players of a similar standard we understand that sometimes for logistical reasons this is not always possible. In these situations, we will make every effort to facilitate your request, however it cannot always be guaranteed.

If we are able to facilitate your request, we also need to advise the following:

1. All other players must contact us directly to confirm the request.
2. Where players have been Graded, all players will be teamed with the lowest graded player.

### **What day will I train?**

Training is held on either a Tuesday, Wednesday, or Thursday at either 4pm or 5pm. The day and time are nominated by your teams Parent Coach once teams have been selected and a coach nominated.

### **What if I am not available on my teams nominated training day?**

Unfortunately, sometimes it's hard to find a day/time that suits everyone. If you are unable to make your teams training session due to other commitments, we will work with you to find an alternative solution. This might be trying to find a player on another team that is happy to swap teams or training with another team in the interim.

### **What uniform do I need?**

To get started, you need only a few items and these will be available to purchase on grading day

- St Michaels Playing Shirt \$35
- St Michaels Shorts \$30
- St Michaels Socks \$15

*Shinpads and football boots are required items - available at sports stores eg Rebel*
